



## **THE MAGGIS CAMERA WITH UMTS TECHNOLOGY MAY BE USED FROM A MOBILE PHONE**

**Maggis, by Telectrisa, is a colour camera with audio that thanks to its weatherproof casing allows it to be hung up outside and the images it takes may be seen from a mobile phone.**

It is the first UMTS camera on the market that allows direct access, without any wires or intermediate servers or installation or complex configurations being needed to be able to see and hear in real time what is happening in the camera's focus area through a 3G mobile telephone (models with video call). The connection with the camera is made simply by a video call without any need to download additional software onto the mobile phone. Another very useful function is that, if we want, the actual camera can call us to allow us to see and hear in real time what is happening after the activation of the alarm entry.

Although it has an unlimited amount of applications, one of the most outstanding ones is as a complement to any alarm system, which when an alarm occurs, this may be seen and heard to confirm whether it is real or not and whatever is happening at this moment may even be recorded on the 3G mobile phone.

The Maggis camera may have a maximum of 20 users, the first being the Administrator with the ability to include and remove users, change the PIN access number, etc., by text messages. Furthermore, the camera houses inside an internal battery that allows it to work without any power for a total of 330 hours on *stand-by* and 4 hours in video call.

It also incorporates a USB port for up-dating the internal software and there is a simplified version without casing that may be used in interiors and that could be very useful for surveillance functions in huts on building sites, patients, children, kindergartens, game libraries, emergency vehicles, etc.
