Lisbon, 16 May 2024 - ARCOLisboa, the international contemporary art fair organised by **IFEMA MADRID** and the **Câmara Municipal de Lisboa**, will hold its 7th edition from 23 to 26 May at the **Cordoaria Nacional**, where it has been held in the past, making the **Portuguese capital once again one of the most attractive and interesting centres of art and culture in Europe**, and a meeting place for **collectors, gallery owners, artists and professionals from all over the world**.

Featuring **84 galleries from 15 countries**, ARCOLisboa will showcase **Portugal's art scene** in a broad dialogue with Spanish and European art. The Fair will be divided into three areas: the **General Programme**, made up of **59 galleries** and two curated sections, **OPENING Lisboa**, with a selection of **17 galleries**, and **As Formas do Oceano** (The Shapes of the Ocean), made up of **8 galleries**.

This year, **Portuguese galleries represent more than 33% of the fair**, with a total of **28 galleries** participating. 56 galleries make up the **international segment, constituting 67% of the total**. Many of the galleries are **European**, with a significant number from countries such as Spain, Germany, France and Austria.

Art programme

At the heart of the fair is the **General Programme**, which has continued to grow this year and will include **59 galleries** selected by the **Organising Committee**, with a number of galleries taking part for the first time, such as **Charim, adn gallery** and **L21**. A number of participants are back again after missing some editions, as is the case of **Ehrhardt Flórez, Piero Atchugarry** and **Graça Brandão**, while others, such as **Janh und Jahn** and **Foco**, have returned to the general section after taking part in OPENING Lisboa last year. These are joined by regular fixtures of the fair, like **Bruno Múrias, Cristina Guerra Contemporary Art, Francisco Fino, Madragoa, Pedro Cera, Vera Cortês**, as well as **Carreras Mugica, Helga de Alvear, Mayoral, Leandro Navarro** and **Carlier | Gebauer, 193 Gallery, Document**.

Also taking part are **SOLO projects**, part of the General Programme, which will present an in-depth look at the work of **international artists**. Among them are: **Ixone Sádaba**, ATM; **Vicente Blanco**, Galería Silvestre; **Carmen Ortiz Blanco**, House of Chappaz; **Miguel Angel Tornero**, Juan Silió; **Juan Baraja**, La Cometa; **Elvira Amor**, MPA / Moisés Pérez de Albéniz; **Miguel Fructuoso**, T20; **Christian García Bello**, The Goma; **Michele Tocca**, Z2o Sara Zanin Gallery; and **Edin Zenun**, Zeller Van Almsick.

Meanwhile, the **OPENING Lisboa** section will explore new artistic languages and spaces in order to attract new content to the fair. Along these lines, and via this programme – for which the galleries were chosen by **Chus Martínez** and **Luiza Teixeira de Freitas** – the fair will explore **17**

galleries, such as **4710 Gallery**, **Artnueve**, **Elvira Moreno**, **Lohaus Sominsky** and **Salgadeiras**, which are making their debut, as well as **Bianca Boeckel**, **Encounter**, **Portas Vilaseca**, **Nave** and **Romero Paprocki**, which are back again, as is **Anca Poterasu**, winner of the OPENING Lisboa 2023 Award.

The OPENING Lisboa space will be custom **designed** by the Portuguese architectural studio **Feeders**.

This year, and for the fifth year in a row, ARCOlisboa will present the **OPENING Lisboa Award**. The judging panel, made up of professionals from the sector, will recognise the **best booth in the section**, gifting the winner the cost of setting up the booth at the Fair.

The artistic content of this year's edition is rounded off by the programme **As Formas do Oceano** (The Shapes of the Ocean), curated by **Paula Nascimento** and **Igor Simões**, and will feature projects that focus on relations between Africa and the African diaspora and other latitudes. It will include a total of **8 galleries**: from Paris, **31 Project**, **NIL Gallery** and **Christophe Person**; from Casablanca, **African Arty**; from Lisbon, **Colectivo Amarelo**; from Brasilia, **Karla Osorio**; from Italy, **LIS10 Gallery**; and from Rio de Janeiro, **Nonada**.

ArtsLibris is once again present at **ARCOlisboa** with more than thirty **local and international exhibitors**. Located in the Torreão Nascente da Cordoaria, **access is free for the general public**. **Contemporary art magazines** will also play a leading role in this space. In addition to being a place specialising in art publications, photobooks, contemporary thought, self-publishing and digital publications, it offers attendees a range of presentations and debates in the **ArtsLibris Speakers' Corner**, where participating publishers will talk about their publications and editorial lines.

Millennium Art Talks, organised by EGEAC

As a theoretical contextualisation, ARCOlisboa will offer its traditional **debate and reflection programme** which, with the support of **Fundaçao Millennium bcp**, will continue to promote the fair as a driver of thought on contemporary art. The **Torreão Nascente** will host the **Millennium Art Talks**, organised by **EGEAC** and curated by **Marta Mestre** and **Ángel Calvo Ulloa**.

On this occasion, professionals such as **Adelaide Duarte**, **Marta Pérez Ibáñez**, **Igor Simões**, **Paula Nascimento**, **Filipe Feijão**, **Mercedes Vidal-Abarca**, **Óscar Faria**, **Sara Bichão**, **Filipa Oliveira**, **Nuria Enguita**, **Raphael Fonseca** and **Beatriz Lemos** will participate.

DGArtes Rede Portuguesa de Arte Contemporânea will be behind a session moderated by **Marta Mestre**, which will enjoy the presence of **Américo Rodrigues**, **Igor Simões**, **Paula Nascimento**, **Andreia Magalhães** and **Ana Botella**.

The **Coimbra Biennial** will also be featured in a talk led by **Marta Mestre** and **Ángel Calvo Ulloa** and with **Dário Cannatà** and **Maria João Macedo**, **Carlos Antunes** and **Désirée Pedro**, and **Raquel Lima**.

WAAU World African Artists United will also organise a talk to be chaired by **Ana Balona de Oliveira** and with **Ekua Yankah**, **Mahi Binebine**, **Kathryn Weir**, **James Oscar**, **Igor Simões**, **Paula Nascimento** and **Matheus M. Abu** as speakers.

The **AAVP** (Association of Visual Artists in Portugal), **Umbigo magazine** and the **Appleton Cultural Association** will also offer a talk, and **Paulo Mendes, Elsa Garcia and Vera Appleton** will be taking part.

And last but not least will be the presentation of the book **Migalhas da História - obras selecionadas de Coleção FAS** (Crumbs from History - selected works from the FAS Collection), at which **Filipa Oliveira, Paula Nascimento**, the book's author, and **Carolina Fortes** will speak.

Collectors and professionals

ARCOlisboa has placed special emphasis on a number of **international promotional activities**, in addition to the **buyers and opinion leaders programme**, which will bring over **150 guests** – collectors, institution directors, curators and other international professionals from the art world – to Lisbon. This is a key strategy to further promote this important Portuguese art market platform.

General public and venues

The **general public** will also have the chance to enjoy this special encounter with contemporary art from **Friday 24 to Sunday 26 May**. To make the fair accessible to an even greater number of people, it will allow **persons under 25 to enter free of charge on Saturday 25 May from 15:00 onwards**.

The Cordoaria Nacional, one of the most outstanding examples of 18th century industrial architecture, will offer a series of spaces where visitors can **relax as well as enjoy something to eat and drink**. On this occasion, the **Lounge-Restaurant**, catered by **Casa do Marquês**, will host artworks from the **Fundação EDP** collection **acquired at ARCOlisboa**. Visitors will also be able to enjoy the terrace cafés – catered by the same company – found in the building's two courtyards. In conjunction with sponsors **Super Bock, Bellissimo Cafés / Marca Grupo Nabeiro** and **Ruinart**, ARCOlisboa will now also extend to other parts of the courtyards to create meeting places.

Exhibitions in Lisbon

Lisbon joins hands with contemporary art to coincide with ARCOlisboa and, alongside the main local art institutions, will host – in parallel to the fair – a **cultural programme** for both Portuguese and international guests that will include **openings and visits to exhibitions and private collections**, among other events.

Organised by **EGEAC**, the ground floor of the **Torreão Nascente** will host an **exhibition of the acquisitions** made in 2023 by the **Câmara Municipal de Lisboa** for its collection.

The city's main museums will offer interesting exhibitions such as that organised by the **MAAT** (Museum of Art, Architecture and Technology) with shows of artists such as **Ernesto Neto, Luís Jacinto** and **Nicolas Floc'h**, among others. The **MAC/CCB Museum of Contemporary Art - Centro Cultural de Belém** will show **João Fiadeiro**; the **National Museum of Contemporary Art of Chiado** will show **Ana Norogrando**. The **Calouste Gulbenkian Foundation** will host another exhibition of **Álvaro Siza**, and the **Kunsthalle Lissabon** will show work by **Iman Issa, Marwa Arsanios** and **Naufus Ramírez-Figueroa**.

Opening Lisbon

Curators: Chus Martínez and Luiza Teixeira de Freitas

Le Grand Monde

One can say that one of the *raison d'être* of art and culture is to expand the world. Different from Imperial and colonial expansions, ours is an expansion of views, ways of doing, knowledges, practices, wisdoms, tastes, experiences and also, economies. We expand the world to be able to acknowledge others, to stay curious, to be empathic, to learn from others, to keep ideas in circulation. Sustaining the idea of a large and open world requires a great collective effort. Sections such as this one entitled *OPENING* are a great example of this effort. Galleries and artists from very different places come together not only to have a market, but to have a reception, a recognition, an exchange that leads to the consolidation of a dialogue between the different participants that constitute the art system or—better said—the art systems. This section has been conceived as an opportunity for you to get closer to the work of artists you may have never heard of. Let's try to imagine for a moment the work of thousands of artists working in their studios to give a new form to the experience of the world. Thanks to them we can have different experiences of the multiple dimensions that make life something relevant, worthy of being lived.

As much as they try to convince us otherwise, we cannot get a deep and meaningful experience of life in our working hours, in our offices, in our homes plagued by screens and series and disastrous news. Nor is it easy to reach those levels of reflection through the experience of sport, however useful and wonderful it may be. We dare say that only art and nature provide us with those genuine and profound moments of conversation with our innermost selves. An intimacy that makes us perceive others –human and non-human—around us with more affection, that makes us a little better. If each of us expands our world by one millimeter, the world expands by thousands and thousands of kilometers. It is for this reason that we must approach all those who make it possible for us to approach the works of artists. In this sense *OPENING* is a section that only asks for one thing: a little time to engage in conversation with those who are part of this space and curiosity to listen to the multiple stories that nurture the generation of each of the works presented. There is no time better spent.

CURATORS

Chus Martínez

Born in Montecelo (A Coruña), she studied philosophy and history of art. She is currently director of the Institute of Art of the FHNW Academy of Art and Design in Basel (Switzerland). Chus is also the associate curator of TBA21. and she is also curator at large for the Vuslat Foundation in Istanbul.

She previously worked as chief curator at Museo del Barrio in New York, department head and member of the Core Agent Group for dOCUMENTA (13), chief curator at MACBA, Barcelona (2008-11), director of Frankfurter Kunstverein (2005-08) and artistic director of Sala Rekalde de Bilbao (2002-05).

She has participated in the Biennale di Venezia in 2005 and has been a curatorial adviser of the Carnegie International and the 29th Biennial of São Paulo. At the same time, she has also curated numerous exhibitions during her tenure at the Frankfurter Kunstverein and MACBA, in addition to other institutions such as the Museo de Arte Reina Sofía de Madrid.

Chus Martínez gives conferences, regularly writes critical essays for catalogues and frequently collaborates with Flash Art among other international art journals.

Luiza Teixeira de Freitas

Luiza Teixeira de Freitas is an independent art curator. Among the various projects she is involved in are curatorial and consultancy work with private collections, as well as active work with independent publications and artists' books, having launched her own publishing house, Taffimai, in 2018. Although based in Portugal, she frequently works on projects in São Paulo, New York, London, Los Angeles and the Middle East, among

others. She is a strategy consultant for the Delfina Foundation in London and sits on the board of Bidoun.

Within the healthcare sector, Luiza completed her postgraduate degree in Paediatric Palliative Care in 2022, an area she has been developing and following closely. She is part of the communication group of the Portuguese Association of Palliative Care and advises on various projects related to art and health. Since January 2020, she has been president of Operação Nariz Vermelho, a non-profit association whose mission is to bring joy to hospitalised children and patients, their families and caregivers, and hospital professionals.

As Formas do Oceano

Curators: **Igor Simões** and **Paula Nascimento**

How many shapes does the salt water that makes up the Atlantic Ocean have? What happens when artists from different Atlantic ports occupy a central space in the city of Lisbon?

These and other questions are part of the many issues raised by the presence of a group of galleries from different parts of Africa, America and Europe. This year, in addition, Brazilian galleries join the program, presenting the Afro-Brazilian production, that is, the work of those men and women who were born in the country with the largest black population outside the African continent.

What the forms of Océano seem to reveal is an artistic production of extreme sophistication that from its beginnings flirts with a dimension that transcends national borders and extends transnationally, bringing together experiences that affirm the centrality of black poetics in the international contemporary art scene.

During ARCOlisboa, actors from different parts of the world art scene will have the opportunity to deepen their relationship with the production of an art that is inevitably born with the language and idiom of the Ocean, which in many ways invented the modern Western experience. That this is happening from Portugal is further proof that the forms of the ocean are as brave as they are poetic.

Bringing together artists and galleries that connect the notion of Black America to a broader perspective of the Atlantic dimension of the world is one of the guidelines for understanding the different ways in which blacks craft their poetic experience. Undoubtedly, there are artistic practices of extreme rigor that are presented here because of their proximity, but also because of their particularities.

This curatorship is based on a conversation between two curators and aims to address these (dis)connections at the level of the visual arts: poetic exchanges between African and Afro-Diasporic and Brazilian artists. Designed to reflect on Afro-Atlantic relations in an expanded way, not only limited by territory and geography.

Igor Simões

PhD in Visual Arts-History, Theory and Criticism of Art-PPGAV-UFRGS. Adjunct Professor of History, Theory and Criticism of Art and Methodology and Practice of Art Teaching (UERGS). He was assistant curator of the 12th Mercosur Biennial. Work with the links between exhibitions, film editing, art history and racialization in Brazilian art and the visibility of black subjects in the visual arts. Author of the thesis Film Editing and Exhibition: Black Voices in the White Cube of Brazilian Art. Member of the curatorial committee of the Museum of Contemporary Art at the University of São Paulo/USP. Curator of the exhibition "Presença Negra no Museu de Arte do Rio Grande do Sul"(2022). Member of the curatorial board of the exhibitions: "Social Fabric (Houston-USA); "Empowerment" (Volfsburg-Germany), Fractured Times (MAC-USP-Brazil) Member of the board of AWARE - Archives of Women Artists, Research and Exhibitions (France-USA),. In 2023 he was general curator of "Dos Brasis: Arte e pensamento negro", the most comprehensive exhibition of black Brazilian artists (Brazil-Sao Paulo). That same year he was guest curator at the Inhotim Institute for the 2023 season, curating the exhibitions: Mestre Didi: The Initiates in Mystery Don't Die, "Doing the Modern, Building the Contemporary: Rubem Valentim and the Right to Form". In 2024, curated the show: Jaime Lauriano: Why You don't know about the Western Remains (NY) curator with Andrea Giunta, the exhibition Rosana Paulino: Amefricana, at MALBA (Buenos Aires- Argentina). Currently he is invited fellow from The Clark Institut and Getty Center Foundation.

Paula Nascimento

Paula Nascimento (Luanda, 1981) is an architect and independent curator based in Luanda. She is the co-founder of Beyond Entropy Africa (2010-16), a research studio that has worked in architecture, visual arts, and geopolitics. She has developed a series of artistic and curatorial projects including Luanda Encyclopedic City, the award-winning Angola Pavilion at the Biennial of Venice in 2013. As an independent curator, she has worked on interdisciplinary projects exploring themes related to post-colonial cities, and contemporary readings for historical themes. She has curated of several exhibitions in Angola, South Africa, Portugal, Italy and has participated at Experimenta Design, Triennale di Milano, Bamako Biennial and the VI Lubumbashi Biennial. Since 2019 she
