IFEMA may communicate your data to companies involved in assembly-related work (see ifema.es) as well as to the administrative and judicial authorities, where legally required. Your data will not be transferred internationally. **Conservation:** The data will be retained for the period required by law. **Rights:** you may exercise your right to access, rectification, erasure, restriction or objection to processing and to data portability, withdrawing the consent given by writing to Avenida del Partenón 5, 28042 Madrid, or by sending an email to "protecciondedatos@ifema.es" with the subject: "ASSEMBLY - company and name of the fair", including your name and your passport or national identity document number. You may request guidance from the AEPD and consult our full privacy policy at ifema.es. Help us keep your details up to date by notifying us of any changes. **Failure to provide this information or its cancellation means you will not be authorised to provide services on the premises.**

LEGAL CONDITIONS

1. The installation of the audio device inhibition system for emergencies to allow the operation the UNE-54 public address system is mandatory when the source of sound is located in halls anywhere that may interfere with the audibility of evacuation or confinement messages broadcast over the Public Address Emergency System on the trade fair site.

Accordingly, all sound sources with the capacity to exceed 90dB and intended to be used during fairs and events (forums, musical performances, demonstrations, presentations, conference rooms, etc.) must install the above system.

All affected customers will consent to the installation of IFEMA's UNE-54 public address system before the start of the event. This consists of a remotely control device connected to audio equipment that automatically stops the sound by cutting the electricity supply to the sound sources when an evacuation or confinement message is broadcast through the public address system.

For safety reasons, IFEMA and its authorised collaborating companies reserve the right to inspect the sound source inhibition system equipment to ensure that it has been installed correctly at any time. These inspectors are entitled to carry out their inspections and any issues they encounter must be resolved.

2. Participation conditions

The applicant is aware of and agrees to the following conditions for the installation of the equipment:

- The device is the property of IFEMA.
- The purpose of the sound inhibition system is to ensure the audibility of the public address system when this is activated.
- Only authorised staff are entitled to handle the sound inhibition equipment.
- Applicants will allow such checks on the sound inhibition system as are necessary to ensure the proper functioning of the system.
- Applicants are responsible for installation costs and for restoring the economic value of the inhibition unit in the event of its loss or theft.
- The sound inhibitor will be returned upon request to IFEMA accredited staff on the date and at the time specified in this document.

IMPORTANT NOTICE:

- If you are an exhibitor at a fair organised by IFEMA, you must consult IFEMA's General Rules of Participation, Specific Rules of the Trade Fair Site and the Technical Appendices to the General Rules, all permanently available on the IFEMA website www.ifema.es, in the Exhibitors space in the Rules of Participation section and on each event's website.
- If you are an Organiser of a fair, event in hall/s and/or event with or without an exhibition in the Convention Centre, you must consult the Regulation for Organisers (Rules of Participation in Fairs Organised Externally, Events in Halls and Events with or without Exhibition in the Convention Centre) and the Technical Appendices to said General Rules, all permanently available on the IFEMA website www.ifema.es, in the Conventions and Congresses space of the Rules of Participation section.
- If you are an exhibitor at a fair or a congress with an exhibition NOT organised by IFEMA, you must consult the Rules for Exhibitors (Rules of Participation for Exhibitors of Fairs Organised Externally) and the Technical Appendices to said General Rules, all available at all times on the IFEMA website www.ifema.es, in the Conventions and Congresses space of the Rules of Participation section. However, we suggest that you also consult the Organiser's own rules for their exhibitors as they may contain additional useful information.
