FSMS 2022 brings together the Urban Planning, Environment and Recycling sectors, with 227 companies

From the 14th to the 16th of June 2022, at the Recinto Ferial IFEMA de MADRID

Over 260 speakers will take part in the MADRID CITIES FORUM

Madrid, 7 June 2022.- From the 14th to the 16th of June, the fourth FORUM OF SUSTAINABLE ENVIRONMENTAL SOLUTIONS, FSMS 2022, organised by IFEMA MADRID at its Fair Complex, will bring together the Urban Planning, Environment and Recycling sectors, with 227 companies and 117 brands from 7 countries. The event, which on this occasion will have a notable Ibero-American slant, includes the 21st International Urban Planning and Environment Fair, TECMA, the International Recovery and Recycling Fair, SRR, and the fifth MADRID CITIES FORUM. That last event, thanks to its collaboration with the Union of Ibero-American Capital Cities, UCCI, will reinforce the Ibero-American dimension of the event. In addition, the FSMS will coincide with the 25th International Energy and Environment Fair, GENERA (promoted by IDAE, the Institute for the Diversification and Saving of Energy, dependent on the Ministry for the Ecological Transition and the Demographic Challenge), and with the GLOBAL MOBILITY CALL, sharing common synergies with both of those events.

At **TECMA**, there will be a notable presence of manufacturers of urban furniture and children's playgrounds, represented at the Fair by the AFAMOUR association, which will organise a showroom. It is a highly innovative sector in which urban greening plays an active role. There will be a notable presence of leading companies in the conservation and creation of green zones in Spain and entities such as the Association of Green Infrastructure Management Companies, ASEJA; the Spanish Association of Public Parks and Gardens, AEPJP; and the urban equipping of container vehicles.

The Technical Association for the Management of Waste and the Environment, ATEGRUS, will organise its usual presentation of the Silver, Gold and Platinum Broom Awards to different entities for their protection of the environment.

Red.es will also be taking part in TECMA 2022 for the first time. That entity, attached to the Ministry of Economic Affairs and the Digital Transformation, forms part of the professional fairs organised by IFEMA MADRID to promote the Digital Kit among the participating SMEs and freelancers, through the State Secretariat for Digitalisation and Artificial Intelligence.

will contribute to boosting the sector will be represented in the **SRR**, such as the new waste law, which establishes that, from July 2022, all municipalities with over 5,000 inhabitants must have systems for the separate collection of organic waste, as well as paper, metals, plastic and glass.

Also in relation to waste, we must highlight the importance of the new European regulatory framework, which aims to improve the recovery and recycling figures, and thereby the development of a circular economic model. That aspect will be addressed in professional forums at the Fair, such as that of the Spanish Association of Paper and Cardboard Recovery and Recycling Firms, REPACAR.

The fair will be the setting for a very interesting series of forums, complementary to its commercial activity, which will tackle the issues of concern to the different participating sectors.

In addition to Ibero-America, Europe will also have particular relevance in this edition of the SRR, which, for the first time, hosts the European Recycling Conference, ERC, whose fourth edition will take place on the 15th and 16th of June 2022. That international event will feature the leading actors in the recycling sector. At the Congress, co-organised by the Spanish Recovery and Recycling Federation (FER) – promoter of the SRR Fair – and EuRIC, the key trends in the market will be analysed. The FER will organise the 19th National Recovery and Recycling Congress.

The leading associations of the different sectors, such as the Spanish Automobile Scrapping and Recycling Association, AEDRA, and the Spanish Association for the Environmental Treatment of Disused Vehicles, SIGRAUTO, will organise forums and activities which will demonstrate the use of materials from vehicles at the end of their useful lifetimes, keys in the Circular Economy chain towards sustainability.

SIGRAUTO organises the 9th National Forum on the Management and Recycling of Disused Vehicles. The forum will serve to analyse the route map and situation of the amendment of Directive 2000/53/EC, on the Recycling of Vehicles in Europe, and the review of the Directive: Challenges and Opportunities, including the recycling of plastic. It will include the participation of the Environmental Department of the European Union, the European Association of Car Manufacturers, ACEA, and the European Confederation of Recycling Industries (EuRIC).

Subsequently, a round table about the regulatory framework in Spain will be held, with the participation of: **Fernando Burgaz**, Technical Advisor of the Ministry for the Ecological Transition and the Demographic Challenge; **Cristóbal Cremades**, Provincial Head of Traffic for Madrid; **Rafael Pardo**,

General Manager of AEDRA; **José López**, General Manager of ANFAC; and **Alicia García**, General Manager of FER.

Likewise, the National Grouping of Glass Recycling, ANAREVI, among others, will be part of this complete schedule of talks, conferences, round tables, etc. The UN has declared 2022 International Glass Year, to highlight the importance of that material in the technological, scientific, economic and social spheres, and its recycling.

. MADRID CITIES FORUM

The commercial exhibition, with all the latest from the exhibitor companies, and the agenda of events of the TECMA and SRR fairs, will be complemented by the fifth edition of the MADRID CITIES FORUM, which will include a packed schedule of talks, discussions and other professional forums,

It will have 50 round tables in 24 thematic sessions, and four debate themes: 'Urban Planning', 'Renaturing', 'Cities for Living' and 'Circular Economy'. In addition, the funding of urban projects, people's quality of life and the exchange of good practices are the major, cross-cutting lines that will be present throughout the programme.

In total, there will be over 260 speakers, as well as experts in different spheres of city management, and over 70 Spanish, Portuguese and Latin American cities will participate. In addition, over 60 organisations and entities have participated in the configuration of the programme.

The MADRID CITIES FORUM has the collaboration of Madrid City Council and the involvement of bodies such as the Spanish Federation of Municipalities and Provinces, FEMP; the Biodiversity Foundation; the Union of Ibero-American Capital Cities, UCCI; the European Commission; and UN-Habitat, among others. In addition, its main sponsors include FCC Medio Ambiente, PreZero España and Iberdrola, as well as the thematic sponsorship of Ecoembes and the Forum of Companies for Madrid.

On the 16th of June, the presentation of the first edition of the Árbol Awards will take place, an initiative which seeks to highlight the importance of an urban nature project, due to its objectives and formats. The jury will be composed of experts in urban nature, all of them representatives of the leading organisations in the sector, and members of the teaching staff of the Master's in Historic Gardens and Ecosystem Services of the Green Infrastructure of the Polytechnic University of Madrid, UPM.

The professionals will be able to visit the second edition of the Good Urban Practices Exhibition, "Green Tecma", a compendium of around twenty projects focussing on the improvement of urban spaces in

spheres such as renaturing, urban planning or the circular economy. Several of those projects originate from the exhibition organised by the International Federation of Landscape Architects, IFLA.

For its part, the Circular Economy Working Group, composed of some twenty or so organisations, will present its 2022 document in one of the three sessions that will be held on the circular economy, specifically on the 15th of June at 10:30 hours. In this edition, that document focuses on how we can improve the collection of waste in our cities.
