The **GMC Expo** space is the perfect exhibition for showcasing technological innovations intended for sustainable mobility solutions. **104 companies** will bring their major innovations to GMC, **marking a 76% increase from last year**. Undoubtedly, this emerging industry offers a lucrative business opportunity for skilled professionals.

Among the proposed exhibits at this year's **Global Mobility Call** are the unveiling of the **new 24H Lemans** car on **24 October** and the introduction of **Spain's first drone-operated air taxi**. A gyroplane and police drone will also be available. **Karsan** will showcase a fully autonomous bus at the event. Similarly, **PwC** will demonstrate CTAG's autonomous bus. The **ONCE Foundation** is showcasing **Access Robots** at their stand, which is a breakthrough robot designed to assist individuals with disabilities (sensory, physical and cognitive) in complex settings. This robot can be used in diverse places including transportation hubs, such as airports, train stations, and interchanges, in addition to hospitals, shopping malls and department stores.

Other companies, including **EDP**, the main itinerary partner of the event, will present additional sectoral advances. EDP will showcase a **Formula E simulator**, **SETGA** will demonstrate **VIAK**, its **pedestrian lighting systems**, **GSS POWER** will exhibit its **ultra-fast vehicle chargers**, **Teralco** will unveil "**Commutie**", a collaborative platform aimed at promoting sustainable mobility, and **Sisas** will feature their "**Pedestrian Save**" **safety system** and "**ECO Bike**" bicycle lane safety device.

As this innovative industry focused on sustainability shows, continuous adaptation and growth are necessary to meet the demands of today's market. In this regard, the **Innovation Arena** is the **GMC's** designated space for showcasing the latest in innovation and research, as well as advancing the development and promoting young people in this field. reason, more than **50 startups** will come together with distinguished **Hubs and Tech Centres**, and **universities** to nurture the abilities of their youngest talent:

→ **EDIH Madrid Region - European Digital Innovation Hub**

It enhances the digital capacities of small and medium-sized enterprises and public sector entities throughout the European Union. To speed up digital transformation, the EDIH Network concentrates on cultivating expertise and using advanced technologies in vital industries throughout all EU Member States.

→ **Las Rozas Innova**

As the "**Innovation Partner**" for this edition, they have proposed along with **GMC** an international challenge for sustainable mobility startups. The Last Mile Challenge aims to find innovative and scalable solutions to promote sustainable urban mobility for individuals and goods logistics.

→ **CIIMA - UP4**

The four Polytechnic Universities (**UPM, UPC, UPV, and UPCT**) established the Centre for Research and Innovation in Advanced Mobility (CIIMA-UP4). In accordance with the Safe, Sustainable, and Connected Mobility Strategy 2030, CIMA aims to promote entrepreneurship among young people, present upcoming projects, enhance participants' knowledge and skills, and showcase their innovations in transportation and mobility.

In addition, on October 26, the **Cybersecurity, Talent and Innovation Seminar** will be held, where topics such as cybersecurity trends in sustainable mobility will be discussed.

Safe, Inclusive and Accessible Mobility

An important challenge for the future of transportation is to ensure accessibility for all sectors of society. To demonstrate the essential strategies for success, as a **Strategic European Partner, Accessible EU** will host the "**Safe, Inclusive, and Accessible Mobility in Smart Cities**" European conference. This innovation and discussion forum during the fair's side events will examine best practices and situations regarding accessible mobility. Representatives from institutional, business, social, and expert sectors will be in attendance.

The "**Movilidad Accesible y Buenas Prácticas**" panel will comprise **Jaime Borrel** of **Alstom**, **Carlos Zorita** of **ATUC-Metro de Madrid**, **Jaime Armengol** of **Fundación Ibercaja**, **Fabio Sgardi** of **Hidral Gobel**, and will be moderated by **Gálata Llano** of **Safecity**.

Global Mobility Call on the agenda of the Spanish Presidency of the EU.

Moreover, **Enterprise Holdings**, a worldwide frontrunner in mobility solutions including car rental, corporate CarShare, and transport technology solutions, will also contribute its perspective on the move to a more sustainable, secure, and efficient mobility for the future through its second **Innovative Mobility Summit**. The purpose of this meeting is to encourage dialogue among the attendees and identify the most advantageous courses of action for the industry. The event is scheduled for **26 October at 11:30 am** and will include roundtable discussions with top industry professionals who will analyse how corporate travel is adapting to the needs and expectations of employees and the public.

Global Mobility Call on the EU Agenda

The official mobility agenda hosts three major events organised by the **Spanish Ministry of Transport, Mobility, and Urban Agenda**, in partnership with the European Commissioners, as part of the **Spanish Presidency of the Council of the European Union**. The *Rural Mobility Conference* is scheduled for 25 October and The *PEP Partnership on Active Mobility* will take place on Thursday, 26 October in the EU Forum. Both events will be held in private.

The **"Rural Mobility Conference"** will address the problems faced by rural areas in terms of public transport. This conference seeks to establish a community of experts who can share their knowledge on **rural mobility**, exchange best practices, and address key challenges.

THE PEP (Transport, Health, and Environment Pan-European Programme) working group will convene to advance the implementation of Pan-European Master Plan for **Cycling** Promotion and draft the ensuing Pan-European Plan for the promotion of **active mobility**.

The third event on the agenda of the **Spanish Presidency of the Council of the European Union** at the fair is **"Corredor 360°: Atlántico y Mediterráneo"**. It will be open to the public with the **Congress Pass Experience**, providing diverse perspectives on the Mediterranean and Atlantic corridors. It aims to improve people's lives and economies by enhancing both freight and passenger transport services through advanced infrastructure solutions.

The conference, kicked off by **David Lucas, Secretary for Transport, Mobility and the Urban Agenda**, starts with a plenary session featuring **Iveta Radičová, European Union Coordinator for the Mediterranean Corridor**, presenting *A European Vision of the Mediterranean Corridor*. Afterward, **Josep-Vicent Boira, Government Commissioner for the Mediterranean Corridor**, will present the *Corredor Mediterráneo 360°*. Next, **Carlo Secchi, European Union Coordinator for the Atlantic Corridor**, will deliver an in-depth presentation on *A European Vision of the Atlantic Corridor*. Finally, José **Antonio Sebastián, Government Commissioner for the Atlantic Corridor**, will give a presentation on the *Corredor Atlántico 360°*.

This event will continue throughout the morning with experts engaging in **four round tables** to discuss *Infrastructure for the corridors, New rolling stock for passengers and freight, EU funding, and Community aid along with the discussion on service models in the European corridors*.

Talent is rewarded in sustainability.

Global Mobility Call launches for the first time the **GMC Awards** in a world that demands sustainable solutions. These awards are divided into three categories and are intended to recognise all initiatives that contribute to the improvement of a sustainable ecosystem.

This recognises participation focused on sustainability, innovation, entrepreneurship, and personal trajectories dedicated to the field.

The aim of these awards is to identify the very best in all aspects of sustainable mobility. The "**Sustainable Participation**" Award highlights best practices aligned with the **2030 Agenda** among **GMC** exhibitors and partners, encouraging innovation and rigorous measurement of results, with a focus on exemplary participation from a sustainability perspective at the show. The jury will decide on this award on **26 October**, and the number of ex aequo nominations the jury deems appropriate will be awarded.

The **INNOWINNER Award by GMC** identifies innovative and technological solutions worldwide that contribute to improving the sustainable mobility ecosystem and encourages their implementation and development through a pilot approach of up to three years. The award includes great recognition within the GMC community, the presentation of an award at the event, and the opportunity to showcase the project at GMC 2024.

Finally, the "**PERSONALITY Award by GMC**" recognises the personal commitment and contribution to sustainable mobility of professionals whose work has enhanced the prestige of the profession and promoted the study and development of sustainability in this field. The **Executive Committee** and experts on the **Programme Committee** will select candidates for this award. The presentation of these awards, included as a part of the **Global Mobility Call** proceedings, highlights the dedication to acknowledging talent and excellence in sustainability, a vital commitment to ensure a fair and balanced future for our environment.

In addition, the "**Last Mile Challenge by Las Rozas Innova**" recognises and rewards the most original and scalable proposals that seek to make the mobility of people and the logistics of goods in cities more sustainable and efficient. In this category, the 6 finalist startups will present their applications and finally, the two most innovative projects will share prizes worth more than €30,000. The award ceremony will take place on 25 October. It will be part of the **Global Mobility Call**.

The Safe and Sustainable Mobility Exhibition is now part of the GMC, with a comprehensive schedule of conferences.

TRAFIC will have a dedicated space in the conference programme, known as the **TRAFIC Forum**, to showcase its contribution to road safety during the second edition of **Global Mobility Call**.

The TRAFIC Forum's meetings will commence on the 24th, featuring the **4th National Convention on Road Safety for Local Police**, hosted by **UNIJEPOL**, the National Union of Local Police Chiefs and Managers in Spain. During the convention, UNIJEPOL and AECA ITV will sign an agreement. Additionally, a round table discussion on "*La relación entre la Educación Vial y la Seguridad Vial*" will take place. The event will feature participation from esteemed professionals, including **Jesús Monclús González**, Director of the Prevention and Road Safety Area of Fundación MAPFRE, and **José Ignacio Lijarcio Cárcel**, Technical Director of the Spanish Road Safety Foundation, among others. At the end of the round table, the **8th National Road Safety Awards Ceremony for Local Police** will be held.

On Tuesday, 24 August, the **Spanish Foundation for Road Safety, FESVIAL**, will host a conference on the challenges facing road technology and training between 2021 and 2030. A meeting highlighting the significance of technology and connectivity development between infrastructure and vehicles, promoting driver training for improved road safety, reducing accidents, and achieving the 2030 agenda.

The FESVIAL conference will feature opening remarks from **Pere Navarro**, Director General of Traffic, and **Javier Llamazares Robles**, President of FESVIAL, and will be organised into two panels: **Technology, intelligent transport systems, and vehicles**, including the participation of SICE, Mitma, DGT, Michelin, Volvo Car Spain, and Bosch Spain, and **driver training and new challenges involving the European directive, road awareness, and accompanied driving**. The participation of the Association for the Prevention of Traffic Accidents, AESLEME, DGT, and FESVIAL also contributes to these efforts.

The **International Association of Professionals for Road Safety, AIPSEV**, will also present the **4th International Congress of Professionals for Road Safety and Education** at the TRAFIC Forum on Wednesday, 25th. Safety, sustainability, and connectivity will be the focal points of the discussions, exhibitions of best practices, and demonstrations of innovative solutions. The Congress will conclude with the **AIPSEV's 3rd EducaCiudad Zero awards** for Spanish cities that endorse Education for Safe and Sustainable Mobility to prevent road accidents.
