LIBER 2025 returns to Madrid to boost the international expansion of Spanish book sector

The International Book Fair will bring together professionals from over 60 countries at IFEMA MADRID from 7 to 9 October, with Chile as Guest Country of Honour.

One of the new editions to this year's fair is the Salón de Derechos with more than 60 publishers and literary agents from 24 countries.

The fair is reshaping its programme of professional activities into four thematic areas and creating the Agora space for the companies to present new releases.

The current scenario for the publishing industry is one marked by international growth, technological innovation and new reading habits. In this context, LIBER 2025 International Book Fair, promoted by the Federation of Publishers' Guilds of Spain (FGEE) and organised by IFEMA MADRID, will hold its 43rd edition from 7 to 9 October at Hall 14.1 of the Recinto Ferial to cement its position as the biggest professional event in the sector.

Over the course of three days, LIBER will bring together a diverse cast of publishers, distributors, literary agents, suppliers, professional associations, and services companies, offering a comprehensive view of the current publishing landscape. It will serve as a hub for authors, booksellers, illustrators, and other industry professionals, making it a real focal point for the sector.

The President of the Federation of Publishers' Guilds of Spain, Daniel Fernández, and the Director General of Trade Fair and Congresses Business at IFEMA MADRID, Arancha Priede, officially presented this year's edition before the media today.

Salón de Derechos: a new feature of this year's event

The international projection of Spanish books will be one of the main themes of this edition, with the addition of the **Salón de Derechos**. This space, dedicated exclusively to the buying and selling and negotiation of authors' and translators' rights, will bring together **more than 60 publishers and literary agents from 24 countries**, including Germany, France, Italy, the United Kingdom, the United States, Japan, Brazil and Chile. This see LIBER strengthen its commitment to the international expansion of the publishing sector and opens up new business opportunities for the global circulation of books, and for authors writing in the

different languages of Spain. It also brings LIBER closer to the activities of other major international trade fairs.

Programme of guests

In order to continue with the international growth of the book and publishing sector in Spanish, the **Buyers Programme**, promoted by the **FGEE** with the collaboration of **ICEX Spain Trade and Investment** and the **Economic and Commercial Offices of Spain**, will bring together **over 300 professionals from 54 countries**, with prominent representation from Europe and Latin America, as well as the United States, Canada and key markets like China, Japan, South Korea, India, Morocco, Egypt, the United Arab Emirates, Australia and Turkey.

The **Priority Interest Decision-Makers Programme (PICE)**, held in collaboration with Acción Cultural Española (AC/E), will bring together librarians, heads of institutional book procurement departments publishers, teachers and other strategic profiles with decision-making and prescribing capacity for editorial content from **22 countries**.

Areas and spaces of the Fair

The **Agora** space will be another new feature in Hall 14.1 at LIBER. This forum dedicated to the presentation of products, services and experiences will function as a dynamic meeting point where exhibitors and professionals will be able to showcase projects, discuss trends and connect with a specialised audience.

The **Book Industry Services Zone** will bring together proposals aimed at helping publishers explore new business models, adapt their content to digital formats, diversify sales channels and adopt innovative strategies to reach new audiences. Finally, the **MicroLiber** space will facilitate the participation of small publishers, entrepreneurs and start-ups where they will have the opportunity to make direct contact with buyers and visitors. What's more, the general exhibition space will once again showcase a broad overview of current literary production.

LIBER 2025 Awards

Meanwhile, on Wednesday 8 October at the Conde Duque Contemporary Cultural Centre, the **LIBER 2025 Awards** will be held, recognising the work of authors, professionals and book institutions. At this year's ceremony, the **LIBER Tribute** award will go to Valencian publishers, represented in person by **África Ramírez Olmos**, former President of the Associació d'Editorials del País Valencià (AEPV), for the commitment and resilience shown during times like the "DANA" flooding in the Valencia region in 2024 and indeed during the coronavirus pandemic.

As Guest Country of Honour at LIBER 2025, Chile will commemorate Gabriela Mistral's legacy and promote the country's publishing industry

The 43rd edition of the International Book Fair, to be held from 7 to 9 October at IFEMA MADRID, will feature an exceptional list of authors, publishers and cultural activities from Chile, marking the 80th anniversary of Gabriela Mistral's Nobel Prize

Chile will have the privilege of being Guest Country of Honour at LIBER 2025. Organised by IFEMA MADRID together with the Federation of Publishers' Guilds of Spain (FGEE), from 7 to 9 October the **43rd edition of the International Book Fair** will offer a privileged space to promote Chile's rich literary and publishing heritage.

Chile's presence as Guest Country of Honour also coincides with the 80th anniversary of the award of the Nobel Prize for Literature to Gabriela Mistral, the first Latin American author to receive this recognition. The figure of Mistral will be one of the central themes of the programme, with activities that bring her legacy into dialogue with contemporary voices in Chilean literature.

"We are very pleased that Chile will be Guest of Honour at the International Book Fair, Liber 2025. This participation takes on even more significant as it coincides with the commemoration of the 80th anniversary of the award of the Nobel Prize to Gabriela Mistral, an iconic figure in Chilean literature. Chile's presence at this important international event not only celebrates its rich literary tradition, but also opens up new opportunities for the its publishing industry, strengthening cultural ties and promoting contemporary authors on the global stage," says Carolina Arredondo Marzán, Chile's Minister of Culture, the Arts and Heritage.

A broad and diverse delegation

Chile will have a delegation of 17 participants at LIBER 2025, including publishers, agencies and other stakeholders in the book sector. It includes long-established publishing houses, independent projects and literary agencies, reflecting the bibliodiversity of the sector and the strength of the Chilean publishing industry.

Gabriel Guggisberg, ProChile 's commercial attaché in Spain, underlined that "Chile is recognised as an emerging leader, for its creativity and transversality in the publishing and literary industry. It stands out for its Nobel Prizes in literature, particularly with the first and only Spanish-speaking female author to be awarded the prize, Gabriela Mistral. Its authors and new voices have begun to strengthen new spaces and opportunities for commercial publishing exchanges."

The Chilean delegation at LIBER 2025 will include **Ebooks Patagonia**, **Escrito con Tiza**, **Minilupa**, **Dudo Ediciones**, **NautaColecciones Editores**, **Calcetines Animados**, **VLP Agency**, **Editorial Zig-Zag**, **Banda Propia**, **Descontexto Editores**, **Ediciones UC**, **Planeta Sostenible**, **Kindberg Editorial**, **Una casa de cartón** and **Humita Diseño**, as well as **María de los Ángeles Quinteros** and **Eduardo Castillo** (Chilean Chamber of Books).

"According to current data on the Chilean publishing market, there are 665 publishers in Chile, with fiction, poetry, children's and young adult literature, as well as subjects such as social sciences, history and literary collections. Between 2020 and 2024, the growth of exports of goods (physical books) was 103%, rising from US\$4.8 million to US\$ 9.8 million. And considering exports of services such as digital books, the total sum of book exports reached over US\$20 million," explained **Raúl Vilches**, head of Creative Economies at **ProChile**

Chile's programme of activities at LIBER 2025

The programme of activities built around Chile will include round-table discussions, conferences, readings and presentations that will allow the specialised public to discover the diversity of contemporary Chilean literature. The Chile stand will be inaugurated on **7 October at 1:30 pm**, paying tribute to Gabriela Mistral with a choral reading of her texts by women writers from different generations.

Over the three days of the Fair, other meetings will also be held with authors who will look at fantasy literature, the origins of Chilean literature and highlight its poetic heritage. The programme will also include book presentations and recitals which, along with artistic performances, will show the cultural wealth of Chile and the dynamism of new generations.

LIBER to look at how to leverage technology and innovation in the marketing of Spanish books

The Federation of Publishers' Guilds of Spain (FGEE) is reorganising its professional conference around four major themes: innovation, professional training, marketing, and sustainability, with more than 70 activities featuring the participation of national and international experts.

LIBER 2025 will take place from 7 to 9 October at the Recinto Ferial of IFEMA MADRID.

The emergence of new technologies and innovation may pose risks, but it also represents an opportunity for the book industry. The LIBER 2025 Professional Conference will address this and other issues in across over 70 lectures and round-table discussions analysing both the main challenges facing the sector and the new developments that will shape book publishing over the coming years.

Organised by the Federation of Publishers' Guilds of Spain (FGEE), the LIBER 2025 professional conferences have been restructured around four major thematic blocks for the main challenges currently facing the book sector in general and the publishing industry in particular: innovation, professional training, sustainability, and marketing.

Within the innovation block, LIBER 2025 will analyse the latest trends conditioning the reality of the book sector, especially in relation to the use of technologies and their application to the creation, production, publication and marketing of books. The challenges and opportunities posed by technology for the sector for the development of subscription models and the development of Artificial Intelligence-based tools for activities like the management of contracts and rights and promotion.

Marketing and training

The marketing and training blocks will include conferences and round-table discussions that will address both the search for models to improve distribution and sales in the current market context, and the skills that professionals in the sector need to acquire in order to





tackle the current situation in the sector. Issues such as the analysis of emerging audiences, new marketing tools, and the use of AI will also be discussed.

Sustainability: economy, environment and society

The European Union defines sustainability as "the ability to meet current needs without compromising the ability of future generations to meet their own needs." To achieve this goal, it is necessary to find a balance between economic, environmental, and social dimensions, and that is precisely what this block focuses on. It will look at the contribution of the publishing industry to the economy and the effects of piracy and the impact of the European Green Deal beyond the EUDR. In addition, it will address the importance of education, the promotion of reading, and biodiversity as pillars of a democratic society.

The LIBER 2025 professional conferences are complemented by an extensive program of activities involving the various countries, institutions, and international companies that will be present at this edition. Highlights include the 6th Religious Book Conference; an analysis of European regulations on deforestation; and a meeting between publishers and the US Librarians Mission, as well as opinion leaders of priority interest to Spanish publishers. The Map of Colombian Literature will also be presented, the situation of the book market in Ukraine will be analysed, and book translation programs in countries such as the Czech Republic and Greece will be unveiled.
